



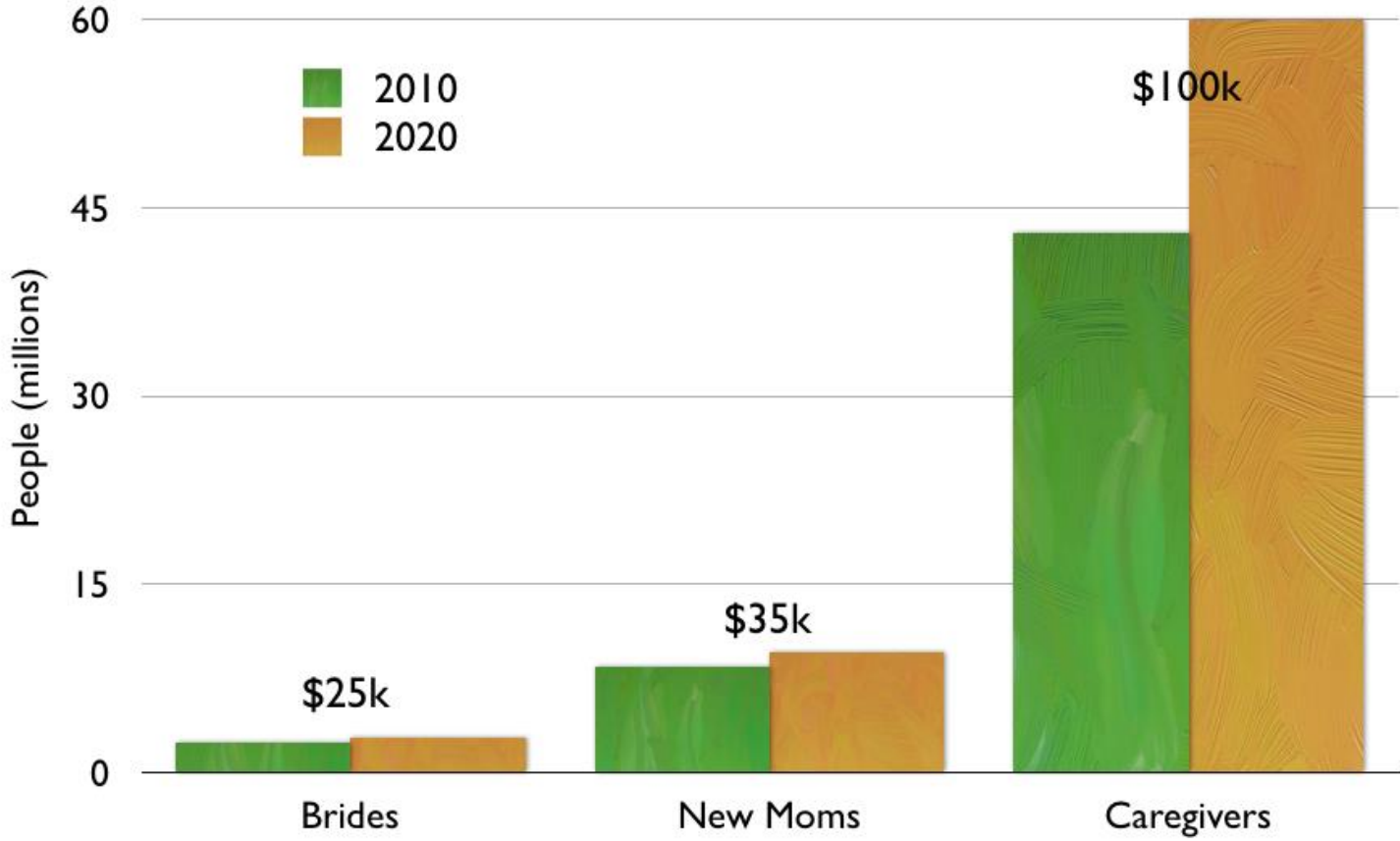

43 Million Americans Are Struggling with Caregiving



Who are the Family Caregivers?

43 million Americans care for an elderly loved one

67% Female

50% Age 50+

56% live with the loved one they are caring for

61% spend over 10 hours per week on caregiving



Internet is the #1 information source for Family Caregivers

72% provide transportation for their loved ones

77% attend doctor visits with their loved one

78% manage their loved one's finances

Impact of Caregiving on Work

- Caregiving has a significant impact on caregivers' "day jobs," with 85% experiencing repercussions related to their work situation.
- Two-thirds are distracted on the job and half have had to change their work schedules.
- Many employed caregivers leave late or early (30%) or miss significant amounts of work (16%), while some (15%) may need to leave their job completely.

Caregivers Working Full- or Part-Time	June 2014
Experienced distractions related to caregiving while at work (phone calls, emails, emotional distraction, etc.)	66%
Made changes to work schedule to accommodate work schedule	49%
Often arrived late or left early	30%
Missed significant amount of work	16%
May need to leave job	15%
None of the above	14%
